6. The data will be communicated to the MAECI's internal and external supervisory bodies. By signing this notice, the interested party consents to the communication of the aforementioned data to the competent local authorities for verification and to the publication of the essential elements of the contract signed on the client's website, in accordance with Italian legislation on the transparency of public contracts.
