

STUDY

Applicants should always appear in person. All documents must be printed out and presented in original plus a photocopy where required. Applicants must provide:

1. Application form duly filled up and signed. For short stay visas up to 90 days please download and fill up Schengen Visa application form [[E-@pplication](#)]. For long stay visas beyond 90 days please download and fill up Long term application form [[National Visa](#)];
2. 2) Valid passport, valid at least 3 months beyond the return date of your trip from Italy and at least with two blank pages for **Schengen/Short term visa**. Valid passport, valid at least 3 months and with at least with two blank pages for **National/Long term visa**;
3. For non-Zimbabwean citizens a valid Zimbabwe Residence Permit, valid at least 1 month beyond the return date of your trip in Italy;
4. Passport-style photo full front and white background and not older than 6 months (**PHOTO**);
5. Declaration of value (if applicable), issued by the School Office of the Italian Consulate/Embassy having jurisdiction over the University/ School that issued the certificate or the CIMEA Declaration;
6. One way travel tickets reservation;
7. Proof of accommodation: rental agreement or at least 15/30 days of hotel reservation. In case the applicant is staying with friends/family, a letter of invitation is required [for a template - [Hospitality declaration](#)] along with the host's ID (valid permit of stay for non-European Union citizens) where the signature of the holder appears;
8. Travel insurance covering with a minimum coverage of €30,000 for emergency hospital and repatriation expenses;
9. Proof of financial means of support in Italy. The availability can be proven through: personal last 3 months' bank statement OR parents last 3 months' bank statements alongside with original and 1 copy of birth certificate;
10. certificates issued by a foreign authority other than the Zimbabwe, MUST be translated in English or Italian and legalised by the Italian Consular Office of the issuing Country.;

The Embassy may request for additional documentation, at the time of application.
